E Comp Michael Smith, Provincial Grand Director of Ceremonies.


Appointed Past Grand Standard Bearer.



30 appointments to Active Office


7 first appointments in Past Rank

SOLOMON: 'LEARNING – EDUCATION – PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT'

2024 onwards and upwards – Solomon developments and redesign

In the last few months Solomon (at solomon.ugle.org.uk) has undergone an extensive redesign. Some of this redesign can be seen in the construction and updates:

- SolomonGPT has been launched. Based on the technology of ChatGPT this allows the
 user to ask questions based on the Solomon material relevant to that module. While it
 is early days for this new addition technology, it does give the user a new way of
 interacting with Solomon.
- The user interface (Dashboard) for Solomon has been redesigned.
- Mentor's Corner has now been updated with "Snippets", shorter versions of Nuggets and "Within hail", material for use with those early in their masonic journey.
- The "Welcome" modules are proving very popular. These are Welcome Apprentice, Welcome Fellowcraft, Welcome Master Mason and especially Welcome Companion.

- The modules are 'gamified' to make the learning more fun and provides an explanation of our ceremonies to all new, as well as established, members.
- In the Welcome Companion module there are sections covering: Background to the Royal Arch Ceremony; Banners and Ensigns explained; Chapter layout and regalia; Lectures (Historical, Symbolical, Mystical) further explained; and brings together the meaning of the Craft degrees and the Royal Arch. There are several quizzes throughout and a final section covering a review and enhancement of knowledge gained by going through the module in total, plus a short video to conclude the module.

Throughout, every module has a video that explains its purpose. Also, each section has a short video that summarises the content.

Each file now has a standardised summary without having to open a PDF, which is extremely useful when using the Search facility. The Tags (words) function has also been revised and is now available in all modules.

Please note the extended link: https://solomon.ugle.org.uk/login/index.php which takes the user directly into Solomon, or to a section for any new user to create an account to access the full array of material contained within Solomon. For any user who is part-way in their masonic journey, the request/suggestion is to go only into those modules you have already covered in your masonic journey, so as not to spoil what is yet to come!

It is hoped you enjoy the updates and the new elements within Solomon.
