 Some 21,000 have whole prostate gland treatment which can have life changing side effects: urinary incontinence, erectile dysfunction and rectal incontinence.






The principle

Multiple intersecting beams of ultrasound

- Focused accurately (submillimeter)
- Targets in the body
- Individual beams pass harmlessly through adjacent tissue
- Profound effect at point of convergence killing cancer cells







HIFU Treatment of Prostate Cancer in the UK

- HIFU has been shown to be as effective as a prostate cancer treatment
- It does not have the debilitating side effects as conventional therapies
- HIFU is non-invasive, inexpensive and effective
- It can be used for approximately 20 per cent of prostate cancer cases and most cases of non-cancerous prostate hyperplasia
- It is delivered as a day case





The Future

- Fund raising initiative to support the purchase of a HIFU treatment ("HIFU") Machine for Northampton General Hospital (NGH)
- This will be the first unit in the East Midlands
- We want to raise £20,000 in the coming 4 to 6 weeks as a contribution to the purchase of the HIFU equipment. This equates to £200 per lodge.
